### **Partnership**

The organisation works in close partnership links with the government of Uganda with whom a letter of understanding between the Office of The Prime Minister for the Government of Uganda and The Board of Directors of the International Christian Care Foundation in joining ventures with Uganda Save The Girl Child about the managing and distribution of Humanitarian Relief Aid Good supplies brought in the country by ICCF as Relief assistance.

A senior Official From Community That Cares Organisation –Uganda J.K.Kuka visited ICCF head quarters

Dagenham Essex London UK , seeking to establish a partnership working links with ICCF

This very Official was formally the Deputy Minister for Disaster Preparedness and Refugees Under the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister, now assigned to other state duties.

International Christian Care foundation has an interest in working with this organisation to tackle female Genetal Mutilation Eradication in Kapchorwa and Nakapirpirit Districts of Uganda.

Our main focus is to acquire 30 acres of land to build a resource centre, warehouse for Humanitarian Aid storage, Part of the land will be earmarked for agricultural produce, School Projects, orphanages, and Vocational training Centre where Vulnerable and disadvantage young people on streets of Kampala City and other major town

(Commonly Known as Street Kids) The war Displaced and former Girl and Boy Soldiers will have an opportunity to rejuvenate their lives by accessing career development and vocational training skills in areas such as:

- Carpentry
- Brick Laying
- Tailoring
- Electrical instalments
- Plumbing
- Piggery
- Poultry
- IT/ICT

This initiative is to promote positive change by supporting and strengthening grass root initiatives for rural community's self-reliance, health and education as one way of capacity building initiatives to eradicate poverty.

Our long term Plan is to train young people in fishing, giving the nets to fish other than giving them fish to eat and still remain in demand for more.

We intend to wage war against tropical killer diseases such as HIV / AIDS and malaria. To begin with the HIV/Aids Scourge in Uganda has reached such a magnitude that the breakdown of economic life has threatened our entire societies. We need mosquito nets and DDT to spray areas of stagnant water where mosquito breed from through mobile health awareness campaign clinicsc.

An estimated 8000,000 to 1,000,000 orphans are believed to have been created by wars.

We are looking at developing Income Generation Projects such as Micro- Finance Credit Scheme, where individual people can borrow money and invest it to raise their own capital and return the money so that it can given to another person with a productive project.

## **Sudan**

Our work in Sudan has so far been put on hold as we focus at seeking financial support for the establishment of a resource centre nearer to the main Air Port and sea in Uganda which will act as a distribution channel for relief /goods destined for other Greater Lake Region countries such as DRC Congo, Rwanda, Burundi, and Southern Sudan. There is need for funding a post of a regional project co-ordinator who will be able to use proper accountability assess risks and monitor projects progress as well as giving us a summary of expenditure evolution report

### **Brief Summary about Sudan**

The Republic of Sudan gained independence from the UK in 1956. For all but 12 of the 48 years since the country has been engulfed in a civil war between the mainly Arab Muslim north and the predominantly African Animist and Christian south. An estimated 2 million have died as a result of the war, man-made famine and disease, and over 4 million have been displaced. The cost of war has turned Sudan into one of the poorest countries in the world with most living on less than \$1 a day.

Our organisation is determined to supports those living below poverty levels, be a voice for the voiceless the oppressed and the persecuted individuals who are often neglected by society, defers of the widows mentors to the fatherless, advocates to the oppressed, by enabling them to redevelop in ways that are sensitive to both their cultural and religious values.

The main focus of our organisation is to involve local communities in developing a dependable action plan that leads to the achievement of the goal of totally Eradicating of HIV/AIDS and Poverty.

We are striving to re-enforce initiate, organise, encourage and facilitate communities first in Uganda and later in other neighbourhood countries named above through the establishment of Orphanages, school projects, training projects, medical centres and rural clinics as well as feeding the hungry regardless of creed, cultural background, or social status.

To further the above we will engage in establishing working partnership relations with British, Churches, Business, investments, and individuals with a call to serve and render support in kind or other wise for the benefit of eradicating poverty and raising aspiration and hope to the hopeless.
